**Beatlemania Comes To Sullivan Saturday**

It has been more than 40 years since a band named The Beatles took America by storm with a performance on the hit classic television show, the Ed Sullivan Show. Now, more than 40 years later, The Beatles will grace another Sullivan stage, in the Sullivan Performing Arts Theater on Saturday night at 7 p.m.

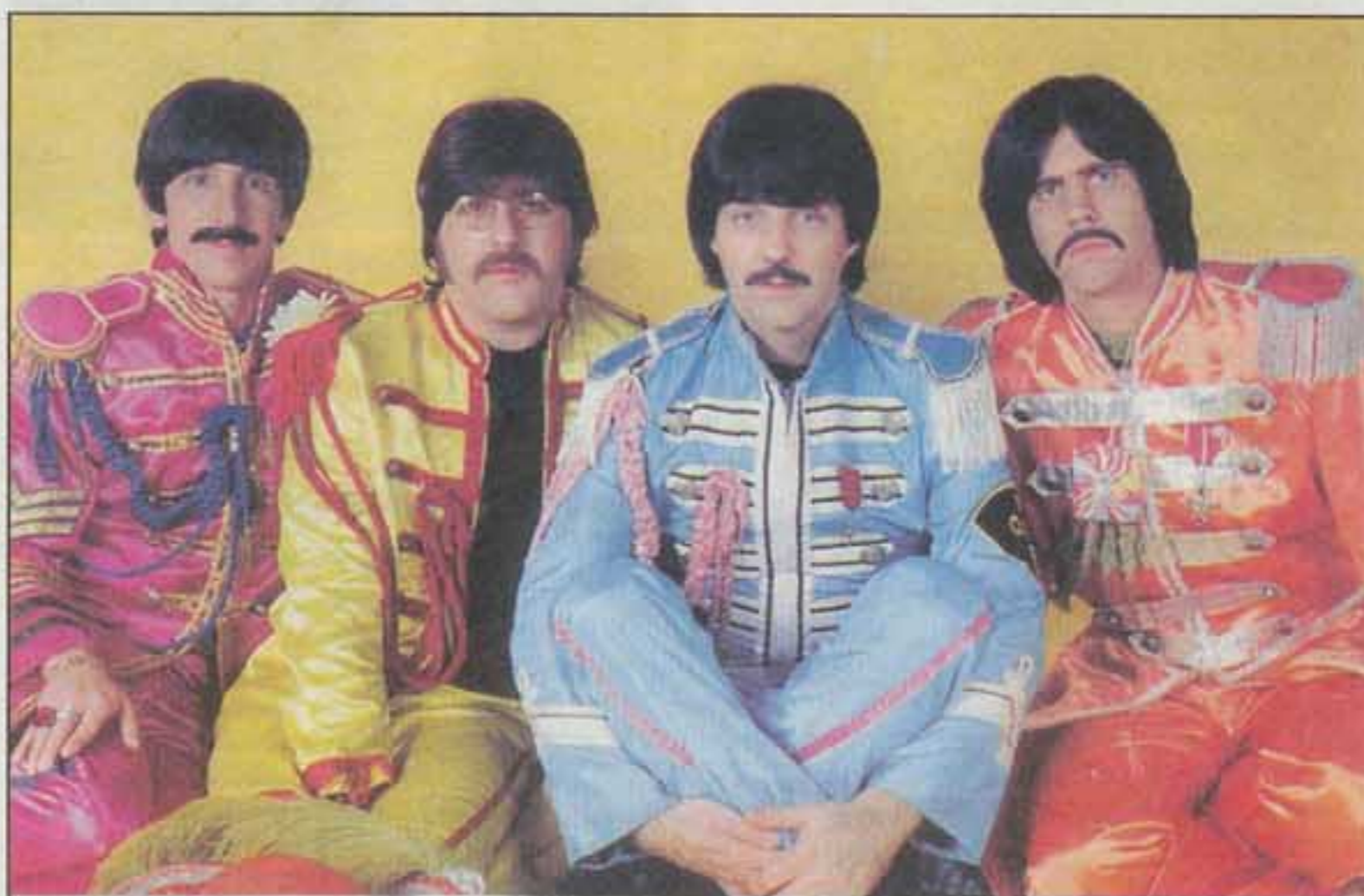
Although they are not The Beatles, the upcoming performance by Liverpool Legends and The Passed Masters will bring audience members, young and old, to the vintage days of rock and roll along with a startling resemblance of the once young British band.

The groups are managed and endorsed by Beatle George Harrison's sister, Louise

Harrison, owner of Louise Harrison Entertainment. The company is also headed by Michelle Dwoskin, president. Harrison will attend the performance and greet guests Saturday night.

The company will bring the two-act show to Sullivan for a cost of \$12.50 for adults and \$10 for students under 18. Tickets do remain for the performance, but are limited, and are available at the Sullivan Performing Arts Theater.

The group's biography reads: "Liverpool Legends (Beatles Tribute) and The Passed Masters (John and George duo) are the creation of Kevin Mantegna and Marty Scott in conjunction with Louise Harrison. They are con- See Beatlemania On Pg. 2

sidered by Louise to be the best John Lennon and George Harrison impersonators in the world.

Liverpool Legends perform songs covering the entire career of The Beatles and on through the solo years. With precise attention to every musical detail, along with costume changes, vintage instruments and special effects, Liverpool Legends magically create "The Ultimate Beatles Experience."

Kevin and Marty have toured the world as "John and George," with their former tribute band, "American English," and have been featured on every major television station across the country. Together, they have performed on the hallowed ground of several original Beatles venues, including The Cavern Club in Liverpool, and have recorded an album at Abbey Road Studios, London. They have performed in concert with Denny Laine, co-founder of Wings with Paul McCartney, as well as the original Beatles drummer, Pete Best. To top it all off, they headline "International Beatle Week" in Liverpool in front of 100,000 Beatle fans.

Kevin represents John Lennon to perfection and Louise says he is very similar to the John she remembers. "It's just like de'ja vu; his looks, voice and even personality are so amazingly John." Marty is a natural at portraying George Harrison, not only duplicating those amazing guitar solos note for note, but also George's unique vocal style. Louise was moved to tears in March 2002, when she first saw Marty's true-to-life performance as her brother. In a private meeting with Sir Paul McCartney a week later, she introduced Marty as "my new adopted baby brother."

Davey Justice has portrayed Paul McCartney on five different continents. As a member of the famous "Legends In Concert" show in Las Vegas, he has garnered worldwide respect as one of the foremost impersonators of Sir Paul. Davey has had the distinct honor of performing as Paul with some of the world's most prestigious symphony orchestras. Fans agree that Davey's dead-on resemblance to Paul, along with his incredible vocal range, left-handed bass playing and boyish

charm, make his tribute to "The Cute Beatle" truly one-of-a-kind.

Joe Bologna is a world-class drummer and is able to completely duplicate Ringo's unorthodox drumming, vocals, and fun-loving personality. Joe is also a fantastic musician and songwriter.

Louise Harrison spoke with the Independent News on Wednesday, commenting that it is truly a pleasure to give back the love from her brother's band to so many Beatles people.

"Beatle people are loving and have an unlimited source of love. It's the one thing that is a tremendous resource," said Harrison. "Most of my life has been spent around Beatle people and they're excellent loving people not nasty people in the world."

Harrison stated that she used to aid her brother's band and the management by driving to radio stations to get the Beatles played on radio in the U.S. She also recounts sending Billboard magazines to England for them to see what was happening in the U.S. along with encouraging them to get on the Ed Sullivan Show.

Harrison also spoke to Sullivan High School students Wednesday who were eager to hear the many Beatle stories.

Harrison stated that they are hoping to raise money for various community projects on this tour, along with furthering the band.

"This theater is so wonderful and I'm going to love seeing them play here," concluded Harrison in discussing the SHS Performing Arts Theater.
